9:00am Depart for Lexington

9:30am The Bob Timberlake Gallery & Museum

Just a short distance from Winston Salem is the gallery of one of NC's most renowned artist. Meet Bob and see his original artwork, reproductions, signature furniture line, home accessories and personal memorabilia. Spend time immersing yourself in the World of Bob Timberlake. On display are many of Bob's most treasured collections from Santa's, Canoes, and Miniature Chairs, many treasures to see!

11:00am Uptown Lexington

- **Davidson County Historical Museum** – Built in 1958 and located in the Old Courthouse on the square in the center of town, the museum offers exhibits, programs and activities that capture the history of Davidson County through local artifacts, photographs and archival materials. The historic second floor courtroom remains intact with its judge's bench, jury box and prisoner's holding cage.
- **Conrad & Hinkle** - Since 1940, this small town grocer has been serving the folks in Lexington with some of the best, most tasty **pimento cheese** around. This is a good old southern taste of Lexington you certainly don't want to miss!
- **The Candy Factory** - After you get your homemade pimento cheese, walk across Main Street to an old time candy store for good old-fashioned "Red Bird" peppermint candy made by Piedmont Candy Company right here in Lexington. The **peppermint candy sticks and puffs** are a mainstay, but these days when you walk in the door, your nose will be instantly drawn to the wonderful aroma of homemade, fresh fudge.
- **Lanier Hardware** – Next walk down Main to NC's oldest True Value hardware store. Although this is of special interest to the guys, ladies you just might find something special as well. "If you don't find it at Lanier's, you probably don't really need it!"
- **Shops on Main** –Take a walk down Main and visit one of the over 50 independently owned shops....antiques, consignments, garden or kids shops....many varieties to choose from, something for everyone

12:30pm Lunch – No visit to Lexington is complete without having some World Famous Barbecue!

2:00pm Childress Vineyards

Wind down after lunch with a tour and wine tasting at NASCAR owner Richard Childress' winery. Noted by Wine Enthusiast Magazine as one of the top 25 Tasting Rooms in America, it is truly a treat. The Tuscan styled winery offers daily tours of the wine making process.
