

North Carolina Counties: Owner-Occupied Housing Rates

Owner-occupied housing—where the property owner lives in the home—often boosts social stability and encourages community investment. Rates vary statewide for many reasons; for instance, Pitt County has the lowest rate at 51%, partly influenced by its large number of university students.

78 NC counties have rates higher than the national 64.8% average.

66.2% of housing units statewide are owner occupied.

Currituck County's 88% rate of owner occupancy is the highest statewide.
