

North Carolina Counties:

Monthly Median Gross Rent

Monthly Median Gross Rent is a measure of the average affordability of rental housing and can be a useful tool for comparing affordability across jurisdictions. Statewide, the Monthly Median Gross Rent for one person has increased by an average of 12.9% (\$116 per month) since 2019; this estimate is not inflation-adjusted.

In 5 counties, the Monthly Median Gross Rent exceeds the \$1,268 national average.				81 counties experienced increases over 10% since 2019.			Graham County's \$580 Monthly Median Gross Rent is the lowest statewide.
