# Newly Added Procurement Trainings: Purchasing Under FEMA Awards

FEMA's Grant Programs Directorate (GPD) is offering a series of trainings on the federal procurement rules applicable to recipients and subrecipients purchasing under a FEMA award. These virtual trainings will be facilitated by GPD's Procurement Under Grants (PUG) Division and offered on various dates throughout December. The trainings are described below:

- Interactive Procurement Under Grants This 3-hour foundational course presents core concepts of procurement under grants in lecture form followed by independent activities that apply the information to real-life scenarios.
- Procurement Lifecycle Training This 2-hour comprehensive lecture-style training walks the audience through the various stages of the procurement lifecycle, and how the federal procurement rules relate to each phase of the procurement lifecycle. Prerequisites: Prior participation in PUG 101 or E&E webinars is encouraged but not required.
- Standard Procurement Under Grants (PUG 101) Training This 1-hour webinar provides an overview of the federal procurement under grants rules for recipients and subrecipients when purchasing under a FEMA grant.
- Exigency or Emergency (E&E) Training This 1-hour webinar educates recipients and subrecipients on the federal procurement under grants rules applicable when purchasing during exigency or emergency circumstances.

#### **Target Audience**

These trainings are appropriate for FEMA award recipients and subrecipients, including state, local, Tribal and territorial government personnel; nonprofit organization staff; eligible private entities; other non-Federal entities, and FEMA staff.
